The City of Glendale Commission on the Status of Women is seeking nominations for the 2011 Gem of Glendale Award. One outstanding high school senior will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship* during the Jewels of Glendale event on May 5, 2011.

The Gem of Glendale Award is a scholarship that will be awarded to one outstanding student (male or female) who is engaged in community service that reflects the core values and mission of the Commission on the Status of Women. The community service should include service to women and/or girls in areas such as: homelessness, health, leadership, and financial literacy.

In order to be eligible for the scholarship, nominated students must meet the following requirements:

- Graduating high school senior
- Live in the City of Glendale, attend private school in the City of Glendale, or attend public school within the Glendale Unified School District
- Registering in an institution of higher education (e.g. university, community college, trade/vocational school, police/fire academy) for the Fall 2011 semester
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Provide community service that benefits women and/or children
